

## Personal Support Worker

### Duties and Responsibilities:

The successful incumbent will provide safe, evidence-informed quality nursing care to an acute medical, surgical patient, and long-term client population by combining interpersonal communication with clinical knowledge and skills.

- Assist client with activities of daily living which includes help clients with personal hygiene. Provide patients with bedpans, help with baths, shampoos, and showers
- Assist with daily living activities. This includes delivering meals to patients, turning and ambulating patients and providing plenty of freshwaters, as well as extra nourishment between meals
- Provide adjunct care for the patient, including ice packs, non-sterile dressings, and therapeutic baths
- Check vital signs and record daily information in the patient's chart
- Assist the nurses and other staff as needed
- Adhere to professional standards, follow policies and procedures and abide by federal, state and local requirements, as well as Joint Commission standard
- Provides each client with meaningful companionship, observation, safety, and conversation
- Participates in the rehabilitative approach to patient care
- Ensures that the client's surroundings and personal effects are clean, tidy and serviceable
- Provide client care within the scope of his/her education and experience.

### Requirements:

- High School diploma or GED
- Completion of a Province approved PSW certification training course
- Basic computer skills
- Ability to work as part of a team and to handle multiple tasks safely and effectively
- Good communication skills, including the ability to communicate sensitive information with empathy ("bedside manner")
- High tolerance for working under pressure and handling critical situations with a cool head
- First aid - CPR certification
- N95 Mask fit testing
- Immunization records (to include Measles, Mumps and Rubella)
- 2 Step TB Test/ Chest x ray
- Personal Support Worker Certification (NACC if applicable) OR 1-year RPN transcript OR 2-year RN transcript
- Valid Criminal Record Check with vulnerable sector cleared - must be completed within the last year.
- Must be able to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing in English
- Must be legally eligible to work in Canada
